
Through the collective efforts of these partners, we aim to gather toys and gifts that will bring happiness to children who may face economic challenges.

The office construction aims to provide a functional space for organizational activities and community outreach.


Simultaneously, the permaculture classroom embodies our dedication to environmental stewardship and holistic learning.

Ver Mejor Vivir Mejor is a vital social program dedicated to enhancing the lives of vulnerable individuals in Ciudad Juárez, Mexico, who suffer from vision problems.

Operating out of Clinic Convision, the program offers free cataract and pterygium surgeries to those in need.

Cataract surgery is performed to remove the clouded lens from the eye and replace it with a clear artificial lens, significantly restoring vision. Pterygium surgery addresses the growth of benign tissue on the eye's surface that can impair sight and cause discomfort.

This initiative is made possible through the generous support of sponsoring allies like United Way and FECHAC, who fund the necessary medical procedures.

Each beneficiary undergoes a thorough socioeconomic assessment to confirm their eligibility for the free services. The program's effectiveness is meticulously evaluated by social investigators who gather data on health outcomes and economic impacts, generating valuable metrics to inform future health strategies and regional development efforts.





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
