



- Prescription glasses = 106.1%








# SENSITIZATION PROJECT WITH TEC DE MONTERREY







## TRAINING OF AUTHORIZED DONEES







Peace be with you, let us all be Artisans of Peace, Juárez and El Paso present with their bishops at El Punto, united in prayer for the peace of our region.










### TALENT DEVELOPMENT 4.0


- 1. Fundamentals of Supply Chains


Eufrosina shared her dreams with us, "The dreams of the mountain girl" where breaking paradigms and raising her voice in favor of equality and women's rights have been her flag.

Another one of her dreams is about to materialize, as a federal deputy she fights for the prohibition and for child marriage to be considered a serious crime in Mexico.











## YA QUISIERAS CANCER ANNUAL RACE









### NUTCRACKER RUNWAY AT CORONADO COUNTRY CLUB








# FECHAC ANNUAL MEETING OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS



#### EL PUNTO

Designed by one of the world's foremost architectural firms, Herzog & de Meuron of Switzerland, the 225,400-square-foot building with four levels will enclose a 92,000-square-foot Spiritual center that can hold 2,500 people. It will also house a free, privately funded music academy for children, a conference center and community center and three executive apartments for guests. The building will have a modern adobe-block exterior and open onto a one-acre terraced plaza for open-air concerts and religious services.
